➤ Greetings from Amanora School!

➤ We are happy to share that Amanora School has been ranked **No. 1** in the category of **Excellence in Extra Curricular Activity** in the Times School Survey 2019.

In further reference to our **Circular No. 47** dated **25th November, 2019**, please find detailed below answers to few of the more pertinent questions that some of you might have in no particular order.

Q.) Will there be a change in the School's name?

➤ **A.)** There will be no change in the name of our school. We will be known as **Amanora School**. The school logo will alter to the one specified on this circular.

➤ **Q.)** Would it affect our Affiliation status and Board?

➤ **A.)** Amanora School is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) vide Affiliation No. **1130452**. The School team is gearing up to obtain necessary permissions of the State and Board in order to commence Grades XI and XII soon.

➤ **Q.)** How would it affect the syllabus and curriculum and books?

➤ **A.)** The syllabus and curriculum of our school conforms to the National Curriculum Framework - 2005 (NCF). We continuously evaluate books from various publishers and will continue with Pearson Mypedia (Books and Solution) for grades Nursery to V and the current Longman and other series of publishers for Grades VI to VIII as defined by NCERT, and the students of Grades IX and X will strictly adhere to NCERT books.

➤ **Q.)** Will there be a change in the Staff and the trainings provided to them?

➤ **A.)** Ensuring highest quality teaching is a critical component of our school's Strategic Plan and this is reflected in staff undertaking continuous professional trainings to enhance their skills and updating themselves on latest pedagogical practices. The school will continue to function with all of its staff members. All teachers are assessed yearly on set academic standards. We have a structured Professional Development program which the staff will continue to avail and benefit from.

Q.) Is there a fee increase associated with the new development?

A.) There is **no fee revision** associated with this change.

Q.) Would there be a change in the Pedagogical Practices?

A.) We, at Amanora School continue to remain committed to provide a high-quality education for our students. We emphasize the importance of achieving personal standards of excellence in academics, sports and cultural activities. The school being affiliated to CBSE delivers a progressive curriculum and value based teaching.
