- School Champions: Aarush Gupta, Indrajeet Gadhave, Janhavi Ranjan, and Khushdeep Gill successfully advanced for the State level.

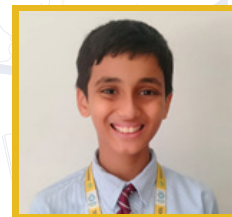
Grade VI : Young Satyarthi Championship

- National Winner: Naina Mittal won the All India State-level Young Satyarthi Competition on 10th February 2025.



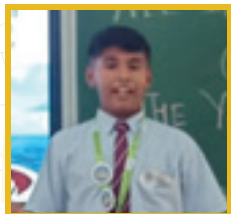

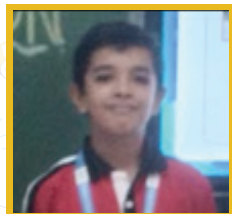

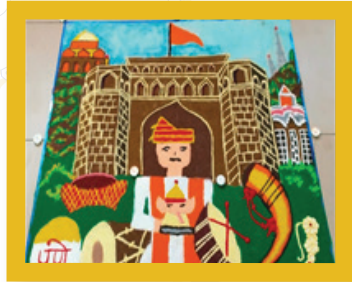
